



SAFETY FIRST

Safety & Crisis Management Planning



Crisis & Safety Management Plan: mediating risks, promoting safety and detailing the necessary planning for precautions and preventive measures to ensure that risks are controlled and safety is never compromised



Be aware of pickpockets: Do not store your wallet/smartphone in back pockets or easy-to-access pockets on your clothes/bags. Also, do not leave your belongings unattended in public spaces.



Alcoholic beverages: Drinking should always be done in moderation!



Keep the bling at home: Avoid going out with expensive jewelry, laptops or other expensive electronics, it is best to leave expensive jewelry/ electronic gadgets at home!



Drugs: Do not be tempted to buy, sell, carry or use any illegal drug while abroad. Whether you are alone or in group, the use of even a small amount of an illegal drug can jeopardize your welfare. Remember that while in Brazil you are expected to obey Brazilian law.
